5-18-2015 Hyphenated Christians

What "kind" of Christian are you? Paul found "contentions" in the Corinthian church of Christ caused by hyphenated Christians. Paul charged that:

Each of you says, 'I am of Paul,' or 'I am of Apollos,' or 'I am of Cephas,' or 'I am of Christ.' Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? (1 Corinthians 1:12-13).

Each group sought special identity among Christians, which defeated the purpose of Jesus' death. The churches of Christ should "all speak the same thing and *that* there be no divisions among" us (**1 Corinthians 1:10**). Those who only are "of Christ" were right, all the others had gone astray. Jesus Christ died to bring us together, people hyphenate to divide us up. Are you a hyphenated Christian?

To the divided Corinthian church of Christ, Paul asked:

"Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?" (1 Corinthians 1:13).

Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out (John 10:1-3).
