## 1-16-2017 Humility In Victory

It is all too easy for victory to go to our heads. God brought Israel out of Egypt, and led them through the wilderness. Moses said it was God:

... Who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end--then you say in your heart, 'My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth'" (**Deuteronomy 8:16-17**).

They had had to gather manna daily to teach them humility and obedience to God. None of them could claim their part of the Promised Land without doing His will.

And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth (**Deuteronomy 8:18**).

Today, no one has a claim to salvation without Jesus Christ, for He said,

"He who believes and is baptized will be saved" (Mark 16:16).

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### 1-17-2017 Whose Success Is It?

King David saw success and said:

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# 1-19-2017 Unashamed Living

In Mark 8:38, Jesus said:

"For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels."

An "adulterous and sinful generation" should be ashamed. In John 8:12, Jesus said:

"I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

When sinners should be ashamed, but are not, Christians must not be ashamed, but often are! Paul said in 2 Timothy 1:12:

For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

Sin is shameful, obeying Jesus Christ is not!
