After leading Jesus' enemies to Him, he confessed,

"I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." (Matthew 27:4)

"Betrayal" consisted of leading enemies to Jesus for personal gain, not truth and right. Whether he paid from his pocket or some "foundation," good works could not cancel the need for repentance!

Why Wickedness Continues

But to the wicked God says: What right have you to declare My statutes, or take My covenant in your mouth, seeing you hate instruction and cast My words behind you? You sit and speak against your brother; you slander your own mother's son. (Psalm 50:16-20)

God describes a "wicked" person as one who disregards what the Bible teaches while:

- 1) Quoting from it for selfish purposes;
- 2) Justifying stealing by calling mass thievery just a "racial protest," or "flash mob," or establishing "legal rights" for the thief;
- 3) Giving legal and moral approval to adulterers;
- 4) Speaking evilly with lies, blasphemy and slander.

Voting for wicked people to continue their wicked ways, is wicked!
