In fact:

The Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved. (Acts 2:47)

The Lord still adds to His church those whom He has saved, and the church of Christ is composed of the saved. Let the Lord add you.

Blaspheming God's Word

To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled. (**Titus 1:15**)

People who are depraved by their own sins, want to believe Jesus had a fleshly relationship with Mary Magdalene: He didn't. She was not the "woman in the city who was a sinner" that anointed Jesus feet before He died (Luke 7:36-50). She was in the group of women who came to anoint His dead body and found Him raised from the dead (Mark 16:1). They assume Christians are like they are, but they're not!
